Bobby's story

Battersea staff had never met such a sad dog as Bobby. The sweet Staffordshire Bull Terrier had been trapped in the house with his dead owner for nearly a month before police broke down the door and rescued the starving seven-year-old.

Bobby survived his ordeal by drinking water out of the toilet bowl and scavenging for the odd scrap of food, but despite his desperate fight for survival the devoted dog had stayed with his owner – protecting him. When the police brought him to Battersea he was in a near-catatonic state of shock. Our Behaviour team took him under their wing and patiently worked with him over the

following months. Bobby was taken right 'back to basics', allowing him time to enjoy food, walks and human contact. The programme slowly began to undo the trauma he had suffered and finally he was ready to be put up for rehoming – a chance to find a new family who would love and care for this sweet-tempered dog. Luckily, it took Kevin from Croydon less than an hour to fall in love with brave Bobby and today the old boy is thriving in his new home.

Each year, Battersea Dogs & Cats Home cares for some 10,000 dogs and 3,000 cats. Last year, in our three sites we spent over £10 million caring for our dogs and cats.

All dogs and cats will stay at Battersea until they can find loving owners, sometimes they will remain with us for nearly a year.

Battersea Dogs & Cats Home is one of Europe's oldest animal shelters and relies entirely upon the generosity of the public to continue the work started by Mrs Mary Tealby in 1860.

Dogs and cats come to us for many reasons and from all over the UK. Sometimes they are lost or abandoned, others are given in to the Home because their owners can no longer care for them. All these animals are given a safe refuge at Battersea Dogs & Cats Home until a new home is found for them.

All animals receive the very best of care during their stay at Battersea and sick or injured animals are treated on site by our expert veterinary team.

All dogs and cats are assessed by our experienced staff to identify any behaviour issues that may exist. Highlighted animals are then rehabilitated by our Behaviour Team to give them a second chance at finding a home.

Battersea also provides two other invaluable services to owners. The Lost Dogs & Cats Line – reuniting lost dogs and cats with their owners – and the Behaviour Advice Line, which provides a lifeline for people experiencing problems with their pets at home.

It costs the Home on average £906 per animal – no matter how long or short their stay.
